

## Hebrew Instruction

Hebrew instruction has been designed to support proficiency for prayer and worship. Students will be placed based upon ability, prior instruction, as well as teacher assessment.

Beginning and Intermediate levels will address alef-bet, beginning reading, prayer service, as well as backgrounds to the prayers

The advanced level will expand student reading proficiency and knowledge of prayers and service. Additionally students will become familiar with other Hebrew literature (Megillah, Haggadah, etc).

# Judaic and Hebrew School



## Welcome

. . . to Congregation Beth Shalom of Corona Judaic and Hebrew School. The following information will provide you with a brief overview of the focus, outcomes, organization, and other requirements of the school. ## Educational Purpose

The purpose of Congregation Berth Shalom of Corona Religious School, an affiliate of the United Synagogues of Conservative Judaism, is to provide all students a quality education in Jewish culture and tradition, through a commitment to worship, learning, and community.

## Educational Outcomes

Congregation Beth Shalom Religious School will produce students who:

- Understand the importance of Jewish history, culture, and values.
- Understand the principles of Torah.
- Actively participate in the local and larger Jewish communities.
- Are equipped for life-long Jewish learning.
- Practice the principles of service and giving.
- Are proficient in Hebrew for prayer and worship.

## Instructional Delivery Model

The instructional delivery based on a developmental , age-level structure designed to assist students in meeting all the necessary Bar/Bat Mitzvah requirements and then lead them on to adolescence in preparation for continuing adult education opportunities.

The following descriptions present an overview of the class structure and age requirements:

### *Kita Alef*

For students who will be 6 years of age by December 31 of the year they enter the school.

### *Kita Bet*

For students who will be 8 years of age by December 31 of the year they enter the school.

### *Kita Gimmel*

For students who will be 11 years of age by December 31 of the year they enter the school. Students who demonstrate Hebrew proficiency may be exempt from Hebrew instruction during the year of their mitzvah.

### *Kita Dalet*

For students who have completed their Bar/Bat Mitzvah. Students at this level will prepare for Confirmation.

## Attendance Requirements

Regular attendance at all school activities is considered essential to support student learning. Students must maintain an attendance level of 75% or higher. Less than this level will result in the students not receiving credit for the school year.

Additionally students are expected to attend a minimum of one Friday night service per month.
